ANNA RASMUSSEN, 84

Kimballton - Anna Rasmussen, daughter of Peter and Marie Jorgensen Nielsen was born Mar. 26, 1891 in Marne. She was baptized at the Methodist church at Marne and confirmed at the Oakhill Lutheran church at Brayton. She was an active member in the church circle and the Literary Society and the Senior Citizens. On Nov. 30, 1910 she married Einar Rasmussen. They farmed northwest of Kimballton and retired in 1956. Anna died Friday, Dec. 26, 1975 at the Salem Home in Elk Horn at age 84 years.

Mrs Rasmussen was preceded in death by her husband, Einar, in 1963; one son - Halvor; one daughter, Elna Brewer; five brothers and two sisters. Survivors include five daughters - Zelma (Mrs Adolph) Breining of Elk Horn, Dagny (Mrs Earl) Breining of Elk Horn; Norma Dewall of Des Moines; Erma (Mrs Wilbur) Dessler of Vancouver, Wash; Neoma Rasmussen; 17 grandchildren; 43 great grandchildren; two sisters - Mrs Agnes (Roy) Nielsen of Atlantic and Mrs Edith Christensen of Brayton.

Funeral services were held Monday, Dec. 29, 1975 with Pastor David Petersen officiating. Burial was in the Kimballton cemetery.
