Christine E. Rasmussen, daughter of Chris and Anna Iversen was born April 26, 1885 in Chicago, III. She died Nov. 11, 1976 at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, at age 91 years, 6 months and 15 days.
