

Edward Rasmussen, 62

Edward Rasmussen was born Aug. 5, 1920 in Douglas Twp., Audubon co. He was one of nine children born to Chris and Margrethe Frosig Rasmussen. He was baptized and confirmed in the Bethany Lutheran church northeast of Kimballton. He was currently a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church in Elk Horn.

He married Doris Jorgensen on May 9, 1946. To them were born three girls, Susan, Sheryl and Jo. They made their home ¼ mile south of Kimballton.

They both worked for the Crystal Springs Creamery in Kimballton for many years. He also farmed the place where they lived. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Air Force. He died at the Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic, on Friday, June 25, 1982 after having been ill for about a year.

Survivors are his wife, Doris of Kimballton; three daughters and their husbands and children: Susan and Mark Larsen of Mt. Ayr; Sheryl and Gary Voggesser of Atlantic and Jo and Mark Worth of Griswold. Also surviving are four sisters, Vida and Gladys Rasmussen of Santa Monica, Calif., Eva Wood of Chicago and Freda Kuhn of Alhambra, Calif. and one brother, Victor Rasmussen of Audubon.

Preceding him in death were his parents, two brothers, Magny and Leonard and one sister, Minnie Pedersen of Neenah, Wisc.

Funeral services were held Monday, June 28, 1982 at the Elk Horn Lutheran church, Elk Horn, with Pastor Eugene Soland officiating.
