Anna Marie Rehder, 73 June

Anna Marie Rehder, daughter of Sina Hegland and Cornelius Wigness was Oct. 3, 1909, at Des Moines. At an early age her family moved to Harlan where she grew up and graduated from the Harlan high school in 1928.

On June 14, 1931, she was married to Elmer Rehder at Harlan and to this marriage four children were born. They farmed near Harlan for two years and moved to Harlan in 1933. In 1939, they moved to Cedar Rapids and retired to Horseshoe Bend, Ark. in 1971.

She was baptized and confirmed at the Immanuel Lutheran church of Harlan, Ia. She was a member of the Shepherd of the Hills Lutheran church of Horseshoe Bend, Ark. She died at St. Vincent's Infirmary hospital in Little Rock, Ark. at the age of 73 years, 7 months and 18 days.

Mrs Rehder was preceded in death by her parents; three brothers, Rudolph, Elmer and Kenneth; one sister, Karoline Wigness. Survivors include her husband, Elmer of Horseshoe, Ark.; three sons, Donald and Carroll and his wife, Marlene, of Cedar Rapids; Larry and his wife, Jan of Binghamton, N.Y.; one daughter, Mary, of Sundermeier of Little Rock, Ark. She is also survived by seven grandchildren, nine nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, May 25, 1983 at the Burmeister Funeral Home with Pastor Paul R. Olsen of the Immanuel Lutheran church, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Buron Carl, Alvin Conrad, Virgil Wilford, Albert Wunder, Arnold Christensen and Lynden Christiansen serving as casketbearers.
