Bernal Reimer

WALNUT — Bernal Edward Reimer, son of Ben Reimer and Anna Rossmann Reimer was born July 25, 1910 in Lincoln twp. in Pottawattamie county. He married Henrietta Jacobsen of Hancock on Sept. 27, 1933 in Avoca, and they farmed east of Hancock. Mrs Reimer died in 1968. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran church of Avoca. He died May 7, 1977 of a heart attack while he was doing field work with a tractor.

He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents and two brothers. Surviving are two sons, Robert Reimer of Oakland and Larry Reimer of Atlantic and two grandchildren, Devin and Shelli Reimer.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, May 10, 1977 at Trinity Lutheran church in Avoca with Pastor Harold Peterson, officiating.
