Westphalia — Robert W. Robinson, son of Roscoe and Mary Blount Robinson, was born at Grant's Pass, Oreg., on April 22, 1946. As a small boy, he moved with his parents, to Olivehurst, Calif., where he grew to adulthood. After graduating from the Marysville high school in 1964, he joined the army and served in various locations in the U.S. plus Korea and Germany.

On Nov. 7, 1973, he married Gwendolyn Gubbels in Harlan. Two daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Ft. Eustis, Va., for several years. Robert was stationed near Bamberg, Germany the past two years. It was near there, that he died on Thursday, Aug. 30, 1979 at age 33 years, during a military training mission accident.

He was preceded in death by his father.
