

## Charlotte H. Schell, 68

Charlotte Hanna Schell, daughter of Ernest J. and Kate Young Hulsebus, was born Aug. 21, 1913 in Greeley twp., Shelby co. She attended school, graduating from Harlan high school in 1930. She then worked for a dentist in Harlan for a few years.

On Feb. 10, 1934, she married Richard Emil Schell in Harlan. Three daughters were born to this union. After their marriage, they made their home in Harlan until 1959, when Mr Schell purchased a printing company in Perham, Minn. They lived in Perham until Mr. Schell died on Sept. 10, 1972. She then lived with her daughter, Patricia, in Harlan until moving to her own home in Harlan in the spring of 1973. This has been her home since that time.
