A funeral Mass for Elmer R. Schneider of Harlan will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Monday at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Westphalia.

The Rev. Howard Fitzgerald will be the celebrant. Burial will be in the church cemetery.

Schneider, 65, died of a heart attack Friday at his home.

He was born on a farm in Shelby County and was graduated from St. Boniface

High School in 1937. Schneider farmed in Shelby County until retiring in 1981.

He was a member of the baseball Hall of Fame in Westphalia and umpired games for 20 years.

Surviving are his wife, Edith; two daughters, Mrs. Clair (Debra) Rose and Diane Schneider, both of Council Bluffs; two sons, Daryl of Denison and Dean of Iowa City; and a brother, Walter of Harlan.

Also surviving are four sisters, Mrs. Hubert (Luella) Kloewer of Defiance, Mrs. Elmer (Elvira) Nelson of Coleridge, Neb., and Mrs. Andy (Mildred) Bruck and Mrs. Joseph (Irene) Leuschen, both of Earling; and one grandson.
