Pastor Sidney L. Schuler, 59

IRWIN — Sidney Loren Schuler, son of William and Cora Williams Schuler, was born on May 13, 1915, in Bellingham, Wash. He died at his home in Irwin, on Febr. 26, 1975, at age 59 years, 9 months and 26 days. Sidney moved to Allison, la., at an early age where he was raised by his aunt and uncle. On Mar. 22, 1936, he married Lillian Withers in Bristow. One child was born to this union. Mr Schuler has spent the past 41 years as a minister in the Church of Christ. He has served churches in Clarksville, Fertile and Correctionville, before coming to Irwin in 1951 to serve the Irwin Church of Christ for 11 years. Then he served churches in Malta, Montana and Mondamin. In 1969 he was recalled to Irwin where he has served for the past six years.

Sidney was preceded in death by his parents and seven brothers. He is survived by his wife - Lillian; one son - Joseph and daughter-in-law -Dena of Nevada, Ia., and one granddaughter Kimberly; by two brothers - LeRoy of Oregon, and Ervin of Illinois; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
