



THE LIFE STORY OF —

Schwartz, 66**

W.D. "Cap" Schwartz, son of Agnes Bruce and John Schwartz was born April 8, 1916, at Verdigre, Neb. He died at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan at the age of 66 years. He was educated in the Verdigre and Winnetoon, Neb. schools.

On Dec. 2, 1939 he married Claire Madsen at Omaha and to this union one daughter was born. During World War II he served in the U.S. Navy. In 1946 he moved to Corley and operated the Corley Store for six years. For the past 27 years he has been District Juvenile Probation Officer for Audubon, Harrison, Shelby and Cass Counties, retiring in Jan. of 1981. He enjoyed many hobbies, but especially he loved to garden.

He was preceded in death by his father, one brother Harold Schwartz and one sister Mrs Thelma Larsen. Survivors include his wife Claire, one daughter Mrs Mary (Veral) Heller of Lawton; three grandchildren: Rob, Jamie and Michael, his mother; Mrs Agnes Schwartz of Verdigre, Neb.; one brother, John Schwartz of Winnetoon, Neb. and one sister, Mrs Mary Carey of Tulsa, Okla. and other relatives.
