

William T. Scollard, 62

Panama — William and Ellen Sullivan Scollard, was born Aug. 21, 1912 in Ponca, Nebr. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on May 12, 1975 at age 62 years, 8 months and 21 days. William was baptized and confirmed in Ponca, Nebr. in 1912. He attended school and grew to adulthood in the Emerson and Ponca, Nebr., areas. On Jan. 26, 1933, he married Geraldine Gill in South Sioux City, Nebr. To this union six children were born. Mr and Mrs Scollard farmed near Emerson, Nebr., until 1945 and then Mr Scollard operated his own businesses in other Nebraska communities moving to Panama in 1960 retiring in 1967. Mr Scollard was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama. He was also a past member of the Sioux City Nebr. Knights of Columbus.

Mr Scollard was preceded in death by his parents. Survivors include his wife, Geraldine, of Panama, two daughters - Patricia (Mrs Norbert Hoffmann) of Co. Bluffs and Carol (Mrs Mickey Guinan) of Omaha, Nebr., and four sons Raymond of Omaha, Nebr., and Patrick, Michael and Ronald all of Panama, also by one brother, Joseph of Westminister, Calif., one sister, Mrs Jessie O'Neill of Onawa; five grandchildren, nieces and nephew and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on Thursday, May 13, 1975 at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama, with Rev. Fred P. Reischl as celebrant. Burial was in St. Mary's cemetery with Donald Scollard, Dan Scollard, James O'Neill, Don Zimmerman, Kenneth Pauley and Jerome Kohles serving as pallbearers.
