



## THE LIFE STORY OF — **Kevin Senyard**

**KIRKMAN** — Kevin Dean Senyard, son of Albert E. and Evelyn Babcock Senyard, was born in Harlan, on April 10, 1961. He died in Shelby county, on Dec. 14, 1976 at age 15 years. Kevin attended Harlan schools and at the time of his death was a student at the Harlan Jr. high school.
