AMY SIEVERS, 64

WALNUT — Amy Sievers, daughter of Kenneth and Sadie Delf Sams was born July 29, 1912 in Shelby. She spent her early life in Ohio, returning to Iowa in 1929. She married Lawrence Sievers Febr. 14, 1942. They lived on a farm southwest of Walnut for 27 years, retiring to Walnut in 1969. She died unexpectedly at her home March 4, 1976 at age 64 years.

Surviving are her husband - Lawrence; a brother Paul Sams of Atlantic; three sisters, Miss Dorothy Sams and Miss Daisy Sams both of Atlantic and Mrs Albert (Mary) Noehren of Walnut; nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents and three brothers, Dale, Kenneth, Jr., and Alvin Sams.
