Omaha — Galen Lee Sorensen, son of Leona A. Troll and Otto F. Sorensen was born Jan. 22, 1949 at Harlan. He died Saturday, Sept. 15, 1979 at the Omaha Immanuel Medical Center at age 30 years, 7 months and 23 days. Galen graduated from the Harlan high school in 1967.
