Mabel Sorensen, 77

Mabel Irene Sorensen, daughter of Libbe Arentsen and Everett Adam Sorensen was born Oct. 6, 1904, Shelby Co. She died Wednesday, Sept. 15, 1982, at the Jennie Edmundson hospital in Co. Bluffs at the age of 77 years. She was educated in the rural Monroe twp. schools.

On Dec. 15, 1927, she married Theodore Sorensen at her parents home in Cuppy's Grove, to this union one son was born. They farmed in Lincoln twp. for two years before moving to Monroe twp. where they farmed for 37 years. They retired to Harlan in 1967. They were privileged to celebrate their golden wedding anniversary in 1977. She was a member of the Grace Baptist church and active in the women's organizations.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her son, Ronald in 1948 and one brother Lloyd Sorensen. Survivors include her husband Theodore, two brothers: Albert Sorensen of Walnut and Clifford Sorensen of Harlan; one sister, Mrs. Gladys (George) Hansen of Harlan. She is also survived by many nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Sept. 18, 1982 at the Grace Baptist church with Pastor Robert Baker officiating. Burial was in the Cuppy's Grove cemetery with John Andersen, Gene Sorensen, Jack Sorensen, Charles Hansen, Wayne Sorensen and Lowell Sorensen serving as casketbearers.
