

Fred D. Stoley, 98

Fred D., son of Claus and Katherine Finsen Stoley, was born Nov. 8, 1883, at Manning. He attended Kirkman schools. He married Nellie Ann Clark on July 3, 1907, at Defiance. They lived in the Kirkman and Irwin communities, later moving to Harrison co. for ten years.

They returned to Shelby co and lived near Botna for many years and then moved to Irwin. Nellie died June 17, 1963, and since that time he has continued to make his home in Irwin.

He has been in failing health for three years and during this time Mr and Mrs John McCue came to live with him. He was a member of the United Methodist church of Irwin. He died Tuesday, May 4, 1982 at the Crawford co. Memorial hospital at the age of 98 years. He was also oldest resident of Irwin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife and by two sisters and seven brothers. Survivors include nieces, nephews and by John McCue, who they raised.

Services were held Thursday, May 6, 1982 at the United Methodist church in Irwin with Rev Leon Wallace officiating. Burial was in Rosehill cemetery in Kirkman with Earl Knudson, Andrew Rasmussen, William Shannon, Leo Grate, Marvin Barratt and George Gawley serving as casketbearers.
