

Alvena Stribe, 90

Manning — Alvena Stribe, daughter of Peter J. and Christina Sievers Paulsen, was born Feb. 5, 1890, in Sutherland. At the age of five she moved with her parents to Halfway, Polk county, Mo., and two years later to Pickering, Mo. In 1968 she moved with her family to a farm in Audubon county. In 1911 she married Frank Stammer and they farmed south of Manning until moving to Spirit Lake, in 1924. Alvena married Frank Stribe in 1943 and they made their home in Manning, where Frank died in 1964.

For the past two years she has made her home in the Manning Plaza, where she died Saturday, June 28, 1980, at age 90 years, four months and 23 days.

She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, by three brothers, Charlie, Henry and Peter Paulsen and by three sisters, Mrs Otto Borkowski, Mrs Mary Jordan and Mrs Katie Musfeldt. Survivors include one sister, Amanda, Mrs William Welding of Portland, Oreg., nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, July 1, 1980 at the Zion Lutheran church in Manning with Pastor Edward F. Heinicke, officiating. Burial was in the Manning cemetery with Frank Vetter, William Hoffman, Paul Vetter, Ivan Wurr, Ralph Grundmeier, and Walter Felker serving as casketbearers.
