Esther Pearl Sutton, daughter of Thomas and Ella (Brensel) Kroger was born in Manning, Ia., on July 14, 1920. She attended school in Manning, but graduated from high school in Audubon. Mrs Sutton moved to the Harlan area in 1957. This has been her home since that time. She worked as a waitress in several of the area restaurants and also at the Harlan high school.
