

Hoyt Alfred Tague, 96

Hoyt Alfred Tague, son of Ruth Holman and William B. Tague was born Dec. 31, 1886 near Kirkman. He was educated in the rural schools near Kirkman.

On Feb. 22, 1914, he married Doris Dent at Kirkman. They farmed in the Kirkman and Redline areas for 50 years. Even after his retirement, he was active in buying cattle, trading farms and running apartments in his later years.

He was an active member of the Church of Christ of Harlan. He died Dec. 10, 1983 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at the age of 96 years, 11 months and 9 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, Clifford and Dwight Tague and two sisters, Fern Fiscus and Linnie Rugg. Survivors include his wife Doris of Harlan; two sons, Wayne of Kansas City, Mo. and Hoyt Jr. of Mountain Home, Ark.; two daughters, Mrs Melba Jorgensen of Harlan and Linnie, Mrs Morrie Rice of Omaha, Neb. and one sister, Mrs Orpha Boyd of Oakland, Calif. He is also survived by seven grandchildren; eight great grandchildren; many nieces and nephews and other relatives.
