TENNANT — Darlene May Taylor, daughter of Richard and Dorothy Millis Taylor, was born July 27, 1935, in Harlan. At the age of 2½ years, she moved with her parents to Tennant, where she has lived for the last 42 years. In addition to helping her parents at home, Darlene worked for the Chicago Northwestern Railroad. Miss Taylor was a member of the Tennant United Methodist church. She died at her home in Tennant on Wednesday, Dec. 24, 1980, at age 45 years, 4 months and 27 days.

She was preceded in death by her father and her grandparents. Survivors include her mother, Dorothy Taylor of Tennant; two sisters, Ruth (Mrs Allen) Beck of Co. Bluffs, and Judy (Mrs Dan) Loveland of Harlan; one brother, Newell of Colorado Springs; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
