

Leo H. Terwilleger, 82

Kimballton — Leo H. Terwilleger, of Manning, formerly of Defiance, was born March 22, 1896 near Defiance. He attended the Defiance schools. He served his country in WWI in France. He married Claire Mullen on Aug. 27, 1924. They farmed near Defiance, then lived for a short time in Denison and Harlan. In the early 40's they moved back to Defiance, where Leo operated the county maintainer. He retired in 1961 and continued to live in Defiance until moving to the Manning Plaza Nursing Home three years ago. Leo died suddenly Friday, Aug. 18, 1978 at the Home at age 82, four months and 26 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two brothers. Survivors include his wife - Claire of the Manning Plaza, two children - Donna (Mrs Emmett) Mullen of Manning and Bob of Omaha, 11 grandchildren and one great grandchild; four brothers - Earl of Logan, Frank of Manilla, Wayne of Dunlap and Dick of Calif., two sisters - Mrs Elsie How of Avoca and Mrs Stanley (Hazel) How of Sun City, Ariz.
