Albert E. Thoms, 67

PORTSMOUTH — Albert Elmer Thoms, son of Charles and Anna Ceceila Hansen Thoms was born June 30, 1910 in Portsmouth. He attended Cass Center school. He married Rita Elizabeth Huebner in Portsmouth on Jan. 20, 1944. This union was blessed with five children. Albert farmed near Portsmouth all his life. He died Sept. 5, 1977 in St. Joseph's hospital, Omaha, after suffering a heart attack at age 67 years, 2 months and 6 days.

Survivors include his wife, his children - Yvonne Clariece, Charles George, Carlene Alberta, Carol Ann and Gale Lynn and a brother, Herman Thoms of Neola.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Sept. 8, 1977 in St. Mary's church in Portsmouth with Fr. Schoemann and Fr. Rosonke, officiating. Burial was in St. Mary's cemetery in Portsmouth with William Pitt, Linus Kock, John Schoemann, Bob Pryor, Calvin Bertelsen and Dwight McKean serving as pallbearers.
