

Sine Thomsen, 92

Mrs Sine Thomsen, daughter of Jette Sorensen and Christian Villadsen was born March 19, 1889, at Tversted, Denmark. She died at the Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Tuesday, Jan. 19, 1982, at the age of 92 years. She grew up and was educated in Denmark. In 1911 she came to N.Y. with a friend to find employment.

In 1912, she returned to Denmark for a visit and on her return trip to the U.S. meet Wilhelm Thomsen. They were married in 1913, at Waterloo, and to this union four children were born.

They worked in N.Y. for a number of years before moving to Harlan in 1916, where Mr Thomsen was a carpenter until his death in 1960. She has done baby sitting for many of the youth of the Harlan area. She was baptized and confirmed in Denmark and was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran church.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Wilhelm; one son Victor; three brothers and three sisters. Survivors include one daughter Dagmar Thomsen of Harlan; two sons Albert of Santa Cruz, Calif. and George of South Lake Tahoe, Calif.; and one brother Albert Villadsen of Denmark; by three grandsons; three great granddaughters; one great grandson and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Friday, Jan. 22, 1982, at the Immanuel Lutheran church in Harlan with Pastors Kenneth P. Alpers and J. Harry Thomsen officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Olav Kirk, Keith More, Rand Petersen, Dan J. Buckley, Gordon C. Paulk and Robert J. Nelson serving as casketbearers. Services were conducted by the Burmeister Funeral Home.
