

Delia Tittsworth, 87

Walnut — Delia Lorraine Tittsworth, daughter of Howard and Lucretia Van Fleet Rossean was born April 12, 1895 at Hamburg and died Friday, June 11, 1982 at Myrtue Memorial hospital, Harlan, following a brief illness.

She received her education in the Hamburg schools at a business college in Co. Bluffs. She had worked in a bank, served as a deputy sheriff and had operated a cleaning establishment, living most of her life in Avoca. In 1964 she retired as clerk of the District Court in Avoca.

In June, 1928 she married William Tittsworth. They had no children and he died on April 14, 1953. She was affiliated with the United Church of Avoca, was a member of the Order of Eastern Star, and the American Legion Auxiliary. She lived at Peace Haven in Walnut in recent years.

She is survived by several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her husband, five sisters and three brothers.
