AVOCA — Services for Betty Turner, a Baptist Memorial Home resident in Harlan for the past few years, were held Thursday afternoon (March 3) at Berthusen-Knutson Funeral Home here. Burial was in Graceland Cemetery.

Mrs. Turner, 85, died Tuesday at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan. She was hospitalized three days after undergoing surgery for a broken hip.

The late Joseph Turner was mayor of Avoca for 16 years.
