

Peter M. Turner, 36

MINDEN — A lifelong resident of the Neola-Minden community drowned Tues., Sept. 2 on the Jack Roane farm where he was employed.

Authorities said Peter M. Turner, 36, was assisting a rendering company secure a dead animal being removed from a pond when he reportedly yelled he was having cramps and went down in the water.

Turner, a Vietnam War veteran, was pronounced dead on arrival at Missouri Valley Community Hospital.

Survivors include his wife, Bonita; two daughters, Michelle and Laura; four sons, Joe, Andy, Steven and Robert, all at home; his mother, Ione Turner of Neola; two brothers, Bill of Council Bluffs and Tom of Rochester, Minn.; and three sisters, Joan Hamilton of Sibley, Rosie Fennell of Council Bluffs and Marge Turner of Richmond, Mass.

Services were held Friday morning at Hillside Mortuary, Neola, with interment at St. Joseph Cemetery there.
