Shelly A. Waggoner, 40

Harlan — Shelly Arnold Waggoner, was born in Lincoln and graduated from the University of Nebraska in 1962 with an art degree. She attended William Wood College in Fulton, Mo., the University of Oklahoma and Lindenwood College in St. Charles, Mo.

Mrs Waggoner taught art in Lincoln, Nebr. City and the Irwin junior high schools. Her memberships included the Lincoln Artist Guild, the Nebraska Art Guild and the Oklahoma Art Center. She died Wednesday, Dec. 24, 1980 in Jennie Edmundson hospital, Co. Bluffs at age 40 years.
