THE LIFE STORY OF —

Leland C. White, 81

Harlan — Leland Cobb White, son of Clyde Cobb and Edward S. White was born Sept. 2, 1899 in Harlan. He died Friday, May 22, 1981. He practiced law in Harlan and Omaha for more than 50 years. He was a graduate of the Harlan schools and from the University of Iowa School of Law. At Iowa he played on the University's only National Championship's football team and served as captain of the wrestling team. During his years of practice he served the public as city attorney, school board member and in many other capacities.

Survivors include his second wife Imogene, by his son and by three grandchildren, a step daughter and three step grandchildren. His first wife Vernie died in 1974.

Funeral services were held Sunday, May 24, 1981 at Burmeister Funeral Home with Dr. Larry LaVelle, officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with J.L. Larson, Tom Monaghan, Malcolm Young, Robert S. Ross, Gaillord Heflin, Wilmer E. Petersen, Grant E. McMartin and E.M. Christensen serving as casketbearers.
