Sibley, Ia. — Elva Evans Wick, daughter of Stoddard S. and Mary Evans Wick, was born Jan. 19, 1920 in Osceola county, near Bigelow, Minn. She received her education there, graduating from Bigelow high school in 1937. She attended business college in Omaha, locating in Ill., on graduation where she held positions in Kewanee and Peoria, later moving to Los Angeles, where she was associated with Monogram-Aerospace Industries at the time of her death. She died at her home in Alhambra, Calif., on Sunday, Jan. 20, 1980 at the age of 60 years.
