

## Emil Will, 86

Emil Ferdinand Will, son of Margaret Peipper and Peter Will was born May 9, 1897, at Irwin. He was educated in the rural schools near Irwin. On Sept. 22, 1937 he married Berynce Eva Constable at Co. Bluffs and to this union two children were born. During World War I, he served in the U.S. Navy. He has farmed in the Irwin area for most of his life. In Dec. of 1963, they retired to Harlan.

He was a member of the Irwin Church of Christ for many years and has been a member of the Christ's church of Harlan for the past two years. He has been active in the Veterans of WWI and the American Legion. He died Friday, March 25, 1983 at the age of 86 years.
