ISIDOR WILWERDING, 74

Isidor M. Wilwerding was born Febr. 12, 1901 son of John Wilwerding & Dora Loehr and died at the Little Flower Haven in Earling, Sept. 27, 1975, at age 74 years. He attended school at Earling and on Aug. 27, 1929 he married Helen Scheuring in St. Joseph church in Earling. To this union four children were born. They first lived at Portsmouth and in 1936 moved to a farm near Earling where he lived until 1961. He then moved to Defiance where he lived until 1974 when he became a resident of Little Flower Haven at Earling. He was a life long member of the Catholic church and a member of the Knights of Columbus.

He was preceded in death by his parents and his wife and two brothers, Tony and Clarence. Survivors include four children, Edward of Defiance, Bernard of Earling, Howard of Jacksonville, Fla., Mrs Larry (Janice) Larrison of Defiance; 17 grandchildren; one brother Al of Defiance, two sisters, Mrs Peter (Isabel) Heese of Earling and Sister Mary of Dubuque.
