Mrs Roman J. Zimmerman, 57

WESTPHALIA — Patricia Eugenia Zimmerman, daughter of Ida and Dennis Sullivan, was born Mar. 17, 1917 in Panama, where she grew to adulthood. She died at St. Anthony's hospital in Carroll, on June 3, 1974, at age 57 years, 2 months, 16 days. On Febr. 17, 1942 she married Roman J. Zimmerman at St. Mary's church in Panama. Six sons were born to this union. After their marriage they farmed west of Harlan until 1955 when they moved to their present farm near Manilla. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Mary's church in Panama and she has been a member of the Sacred Heart Catholic church in Manilla since moving there. She was also a member of the Rosary Society of this church.

Mrs Zimmerman was preceded in death by her parents and one sister, Catherine Sullivan. She is survived by her husband, Roman; her sons -
