## **Dewey Andersen, 64**

**Jan. 23, 1929 - Jan. 7, 1994**

**Hinsdale, IL** - Dewey James Andersen, son of George and Ruth (Petersen) Andersen was born Jan. 23, 1929 at Kimballton. He died Jan. 7, 1994 at Hinsdale Hospital in Hinsdale, IL at age 64 years, 11 months and 15 days. He attended country school and graduated from Harlan High School in 1946. Aug. 5, 1948, he entered the United States Navy, serving his country during the Korean Conflict. After his honorable discharge July 3, 1952 he returned to Shelby County to work for his uncle in the produce business,

Aug. 4, 1956 he married Joanne Rasmussen in Harlan. Two children were born to this union. After their marriage, they moved to Omaha, NE where Dewey became employed by TRW. Shortly thereafter he transferred to Indianapolis, IN for four years, and in 1962 they moved to Chicago. In 1969 he became employed for Engine Ware Distributing, and in 1989 began employment with Midwest Engine Ware. Dewey and Joanne have continued to live in their present home in Hinsdale, IL since that time.

He was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife, Joanne Andersen of Hinsdale, IL; his children, D. Jay Andersen of Hinsdale and Stacy Jo Andersen, of Mount Prospect, IL; three sisters, Patricia Morgan of Ottumwa; Ella Marie Olmstead of Hayward, CA and Mary Lu Woodford of Cincinnati, OH; a brother, George L. Andersen, Jr. of San Bruno, CA; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
