KIMBALLTON — Jeanene Claire Andersen was born Feb. 12, 1938 on a farm in Shelby County. Her parents were Svend and Gladys M. (Petersen) Andersen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran Church in Elk Horn, where she was currently a member. She graduated from Elk Horn-Kimballton High School in 1956.
