ELK HORN - Milo Chris Andersen was born Nov. 10, 1915, to Andrew Chris and Magdelene Jensen Andersen in Rorbeck. He died Oct. 21, 1996, at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn at age 80. He attended country school at Clay No. 4 near Elk Horn.

April 14, 1940 he married Mildred Hansen at the Bethany Lutheran Church in rural Kimballton. To this union two children were born, Wayne and Janet. They made their home for one year in Rorbeck, lived four years east of Kimballton and then moved back to a farm in Rorbeck and lived there until moving to their present home in Elk Horn in 1980. After retiring from farming and moving to Elk Horn, Milo worked for the Danish Mutual Insurance Company for 18 years, served as County Assessor for Clay Township for a number of years and was very active in getting the Danish Windmill in Elk Horn. He was a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran Church, had served on the church board and was a 4-H leader.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two sisters, Margaret Lange and Lillian Lange. He is survived by his wife, Mildred of Elk Horn; a son, Wayne Andersen (Judith) of Omaha, NE; a daughter, Janet Johnson (Doug) of Des Moines; four grandchildren; one sister, Ruby Scott of Sun City, CA and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Oct. 24, 1996, at the Elk Horn Lutheran Church with Pastor Michael Williams officiating and Pastor Stephen Gronseth, assisting.
