SHELBY – Burton Fredrick Arentsen was born July 9, 1916 in Avoca. He was the son of Harry and Anna Troll Arentsen and was one of two children in the family. He attended school in Walnut and graduated in 1933.

He married Maxine Pedersen in Papillion, NE., Sept. 24, 1942. They were the parents of four children. In addition to farming, he was a school bus driver for 21 years and was a substitute mail carrier. He was a member of the Shelby Fire Dept. He died June 26, 1991 at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co.
