IRWIN — Dallas Armentrout, son of William and Maude Symmons Armentrout was born Feb. 9, 1906 in Irwin. He farmed and lived with his parents until he was 39 years of age. He spent the next 16 years in Clarinda and for the past 26 years has been a resident of the Shelby County Care Facility. He died Nov. 18, 1987, at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn, at age 81 years, 9 months and 9 days.
