

## **Lucille Ruth Arnold, 75**

**Jan. 30, 1917 — Nov. 9, 1992**

**MANILLA** — Lucille, daughter of Julius and Dora Hennings Hansen, was born Jan. 30, 1917 on a farm north of Walnut. She was baptized at the Peace Evangelical Lutheran in 1917 and was also confirmed at that church. She attended country school and graduated from Walnut School in 1935. Following graduation, she taught country school for three years in Pottawattamie County.

In 1936, she met Mervin Arnold of Buck Grove. They were married May 28, 1939 at the Lutheran Parsonage in Walnut. They farmed nine miles south of Denison on the family farm until they retired from farming in 1978. At that time they bought a home in Manilla. She was a member of the Ladies Aid at Zion Lutheran Church in Denison for over 35 years, serving as president and vice-president. She also taught Sunday school for six years at Zion Lutheran Church in Denison. She had been in failing health for a year before her death Nov. 9, 1992, at Immanuel Medical Center in Omaha at age 75 years, nine months and 10 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by her husband, Mervin of Manilla; a daughter, Sharlene (Kenneth) Hansen of Denison; three granddaughters; a brother, Vern Hansen of Des Moines; other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held Nov. 12, 1992 at Trinity Lutheran Church, Manilla with Pastor Glenn Wiechmann, officiating. Casketbearers were Harold Olson Sr., Harold Holdsworth, Arlo Claussen, Walter Beermann, John Rath and Leonard Ohrt. Burial was in Zion Lutheran cemetery, Denison.
