Harlan - David Conrad Anderson, son of Cleo and Betty (Schleimer) Anderson was born Dec. 16, 1953 at Harlan. He attended school in Harlan, graduating from Harlan High School in 1973. After graduation he held various jobs including carpentry and masonry.
