HARLAN - Jean Andreassen, daughter of Hal and Ruth (Lewis) Campell, was born Feb. 13, 1923, at Harlan. She attended grade school in Harlan and graduated from Harlan High School in 1941. After high school she attended Nebraska Methodist School of Nursing in Omaha, and graduated as a registered nurse. She then worked in hospitals in Florida, Texas and California before returning to Harlan in 1946, where she was a nurse in the office of Dr. Savage and Drs. Donlin and Markham.

April 11, 1951, she married Ed Andreassen in Phoenix, AZ. They continued to live in Harlan as well as spending time at their lake home in the summer and the winter months in Sun City West, AZ. She died at her home in Spirit Lake, Aug. 27, 1997, at age 74 years, six months and 14 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Ed in 1994, and her sister, Mardi. Survivors include her daughter, Mardi (Steve) Allen of Clive; two grandsons, Michael Ahlers of Weston, CT and Mitchel Ahlers of Norwalk, and other relatives.
