She was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Persia. She attended country school at Cass Center near Portsmouth, and graduated from Logan High School in 1936.

She married Harold Arbaugh April 15, 1945. Two children were born to this union, Betty and Harold. She taught country school and worked at Blue Star Foods in Council Bluffs, and waitressed in several area cafes. She died July 15, 2001, at the Oakland Manor in Oakland, at age 82 years, four months and 16 days.
