SHELBY - Patricia Alice Bothwell was born in Clarinda July 13, 1928, daughter of Herbert and Alice Lehman Owen. She was one of four children in the family. She attended grade school in Bedford and attended high school in Clarinda, graduating in 1946. She received her Associates Degree from Clarinda Junior College. After graduating from Junior College she moved to Shelby, where she taught the 6th grade.

She married Clinton Bothwell June 18, 1950 at Clarinda. They made their home on the Bothwell family farm near Shelby. She was a member of the United Methodist Church along with the Women's Fellowship of the church. She and Clinton were sponsors of the MYF of the church for many years. She had been an active member of the Order of the Eastern Star, while Shelby's Chapter was active and also belonged to many other community organizations. She died at Jennie Edmundson Hospital at Co. Bluffs April 14, 1989 at age 60 years.
