## **Grace R. Brodersen, 85**

**HARLAN** - Grace Roselyn Brodersen, daughter of Dr. Sam and Mary Spencer Beaver was born Nov. 2, 1902 at Kirkman. She was raised and educated in the Harlan area and taught rural school in Shelby County. On Nov. 12, 1921, she married Jacob D. Brodersen and to this union three children were born. They lived in Harlan for many years, where she was a member of the Congregational Christian Church, Zenobia Rebekah Lodge No. 286 of which she was a Past Noble Grand. She has been a resident of Loveland, CO since 1980 and she died there June 23, 1988, at age 85 years, 7 months and 21 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Jacob in 1987, son Robert; one brother and five sisters. Survivors include two daughters, Mary Katheryn Mullaney and Cynthia (Mrs Roger) Kurtz both of Loveland, CO. She is also survived by 7 grandchildren; 8 great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews and other relatives.
