

Rex Larrimer Burd, 79 September 11, 1915-May 28 1995

Kimballton- Rex Larrimer Burd was born Sept. 11, 1915 to Cecil Rex and Mary Blanche Carter Burd in St. Charles. He died May 18, 1995 at St. Joseph Hospital in Omaha at age 79. He spent most of his early childhood years at the Elim Children's Home in Elk Horn and received his education at Elk Horn, through the ninth grade.

June 9, 1946 he married Dorothy Irene Ingerslev at Bethany Lutheran Church, who preceded him in death in 1986. They were the parents of two children, Craig and Cynthia. He was a long time member of the Kimballton-Elk Horn community. He operated the DX filling station in Kimballton, had a sanitation route in Kimballton, Elk Horn and Jacksonville, and was a crafted Carpenter-Mason before his retirement in 1982.

He is survived by his children, Craig Rex Burd (Cathleen) of Chanhassen, MN and Cynthia Diane (Burd) Dorsey (Mark) of Coweta, OK; five grandchildren one cousin and other relatives. He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, Dorothy and younger brothers Max, George, Ross (a WWI casualty) and a half brother Richard Harrison.

Funeral services were held June 1, 1995 at the Bethany Lutheran Church, rural Kimballton with Rev. Marcia Hall officiating. Burial was in the Bethany Lutheran cemetery.
