WALNUT — Services for former school superintendent Fred Raymond Burnham of Walnut are at 1:30 p.m. Thursday (Feb. 4) at the Walnut Presbyterian Church. Interment will be in Flindt Cemetery near Griswold.

Burnham, 86, died Sun., Jan. 31, 1988, at Cass County Memorial Hospital, Atlantic.
