HARLAN - Frank Joseph Barone was born Feb. 12, 1955, in New York City, NY, son of Falco and Theresa Cooper Barone. He was raised on Long Island where he received his education and graduated from high school. In 1977, he received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Peru State College in Peru, NE. Following his schooling, he was employed as a laborer in the meat packing industry at Rockport, MO and Dubuque Pack in Denison.

In 1988, he married Lucy Rumble in Phoenix, AZ, and their union was blessed with one son, Dustin. They made their home in Arizona where he was employed at Sunland Beef in Tolleson. In October of 1996, he returned to Iowa and made his home in Harlan where he was employed at Variety Distributors at the time of his death. He died Dec. 29, 1997, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 42 years, 10 months and 17 days. He was a member of the Catholic faith.
