CORAL, MI — Harry H. Book, Coral, MI, was born in Omaha, NE March 25, 1913, and died August 29, 1993, at the Garden City, MI hospital. He was the son of Charles A. Book and Erie Book Lahr and was a resident of Harlan until after graduation from Harlan High School in 1932. He served in the U.S. Navy for 26 years, and after retirement from the Navy worked in the U.S. Immigration Service for 10 years.

He married the former Frances Hertert, also of Harlan, and they were the parents of four children.

He was preceded in death by his wife Frances in 1991, his parents, a son Michael in 1989 and a granddaughter Bobbie, in 1988. Surviving are two daughters, Kathleen Gelderbloom (Kenneth) of Garden City, MI, Monica Mitchell of Westland, MI, one son Steven (Shirley) of Southfield, MI, two sisters and brothers-in-law: Patricia Perry (Samuel) of Omaha, NE, and Norma Liebers (George) of Springfield, NE, nine grandchildren, two great grandchildren & several nieces and nephews.
