

Richard Brammann, Jr., 57 Aug. 14, 1951 - Jan. 23, 2009

AVOCA - Richard Joseph Brammann, Jr. was born on August 14. 1951, to Richard and Yvon (McFerran) Brammann. He was baptized at the Avoca Lutheran Church and confirmed at the Shelby Lutheran Church. He attended school at the Shelby-Tennant High School and graduated with the Class of 1970. He entered the United State Marine Corps on August 30, 1971 and was stationed in Japan before being honorably discharged from the service on August 29, 1975 in Yuma, AZ. He worked as an Operations Manager while serving his country. Richard worked at Wings of America Truck Plaza in Avoca, but most recently worked for the City of



Avoca as a maintenance person. In the summers, he could be found weedeating up to seventy hours a week! He was a hard worker and enjoyed all his jobs. He enjoyed the outdoors and would spend his free time, fishing, hunting, or trapping. Richard died on Friday, January 23, 2009, having attained the age of fifty-seven years, five months, and nine days.

Richard was preceded in death by his parents.
