ATCHISON, KS — Sister Elizabeth Ann Brazzel, O.S.B., a native of Purcell, KS, was born Aug. 15, 1908 and was the eighth of 10 children of Michael and Elizabeth Tuoghey Brazzel. She was a member of the Board of Directors of Mount St. Scholastica Academy. Sister Elizabeth Ann helped to begin the centering prayer retreats in this area. Sister Elizabeth Ann was principal and teacher at St. Joseph's High School, Shawnee, KS; at Bishop Lillis High School in Kansas City, MO; at St. Mary's School in Portsmouth; at St. Joseph's School, Beatrice, NE; and Sts. Peter and Paul School, Seneca, KS. She died Nov. 30, 2004 at age 96.

She is survived by nieces, nephews, cousins and her Benedictine family.

Mass of Resurrection was held Dec. 2, 2004, in the chapel, followed by burial in the community cemetery.
