

## The Life Story of --

**EDWIN J. BUMAN, 60**

Edwin John Buman was born Oct. 7, 1903 in Lincoln township, Shelby county, Ia., the son of John and Helen Buman. He died Oct. 20, 1933 at St. Mary's hospital in Rochester, Minn. at the age of 60 years and 22 days. Edwin was a graduate of Tennant high school and attended Creighton University in Omaha and Iowa State University.

April 2, 1924 Edwin married Lorena Mary Ryan at St. Patrick's church in Monona, Ia. To this union four children were born. They lived on a farm on route 1, Harlan. Edwin was a farmer at the time of his death. He was a member of St. Mary's church Portsmouth all his life. He belonged to St. Mary's Holy Name Society and Knights of Columbus, Earling Council No. 1741 at Earling and was affiliated with Pi Kappa Phi Fraternity.

An infant daughter, Rita Anne, preceded him in death.

Survivors include his wife Lorena; two daughters — Mrs Charles (Mary Margaret) McCarthy of Ganger, Ind. and Teresa of Harlan; one son, Edwin J. Jr. of Harlan; two granddaughters — Kristin and Michelle McCarthy; three sisters — Mrs Omar (Corine) Anastasi, Mrs Joe (Bernice) Schomer, both of Harlan and Mrs Joe (Wanda) Jurschak

of Portsmouth and one brother, Kenneth J. Buman of Harlan.

Funeral services were held Nov. 1, 1933 at St. Mary's church in Portsmouth. Very Rev Mgr Michael W. Schwarts was celebrant of the requiem high mass. Pallbearers were James Ryan, John Buman II, James Anastasi, Robert Anastasi, Joe Schomer, Jr. and Joe Jurschak, Jr. Burial was in St. Mary's Cemetery.
